Brent spent many long days preparing for the course, which needed major adjustments due to newer software being taught. It was worth it! For 10 days the eight students were bombarded with printing, color and typographical terms. They learned how to change and create documents for printing, modify photographs, categorize large amounts of files and how to work with a printer. We had the privilege of traveling to a

Another stated: "It was a joy to come to class every day. I wish school had been this fun!"

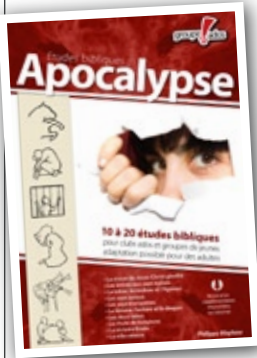
Lord-willing, Brent will be going to Bulgaria in June to teach another course.
