There is an amazing amount of repetition in the Bible. Much of the law is repeated in Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy. Psalm 136 is perhaps the most known example of repetition in God's Word.

Those repeats were not mistakes. God, in His wisdom, repeats His message to help us remember.

Repeat projects

We're always looking for new and creative ideas for worksheets, Bible memory verses and central truths. We also need to make the ideas easy to translate.

Having finished packs for *Moses: Chosen Deliverer* and *Life of Christ 3*, we're working on finishing *Life of Christ 4*. We plan to work on two packs on the life and reign of David to be finished early next year.
